




## MESSEGE FROM HER

## EARLY LIFE

Savita Ali was born in Naraina village, Panipat, Haryana, into a middle-class family where gender biases were deeply entrenched. While her brothers attended English-medium schools, she studied in a government girls' school, reflecting the societal norms that limited opportunities for women. In her village, girls were rarely educated beyond the 10th grade, and early marriage was the expectation, but her mother supported her ambitions despite pressure from relatives. Growing up introverted yet observant, she witnessed caste discrimination and the systemic oppression of women, which ignited her passion for justice. Her turning point came when she joined the National Campaign on Dalit Human Rights (NCDHR), where she engaged with Dalit women, sanitation workers, and manual scavengers, deepening her resolve to fight injustice. These early experiences shaped her decision to pursue law as a means of challenging oppression and advocating for marginalized communities.

**Savita Ali** holds a Bachelor of Arts (B.A.) and a Bachelor of Laws (LL.B.), equipping her with a strong foundation in legal advocacy. She further pursued a Master of Social Work (MSW) to deepen her understanding of social justice and community engagement. 
